INFORMATION

CAUTION

- To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.

NOTICE

- Take care not to damage the painted surfaces of the motorcycle.

NOTE:

- Heat the bonding surfaces with a hair dryer if the ambient air temperature is below 21°C (70°F).
- The adhesive reaches full strength in 72 hours. Wait at least 24 hours before riding your motorcycle.
- Before installation, remove all dust, sand, etc. from fuel tank and tank bag, as otherwise the fuel tank may be damaged.
- Save all removed parts unless otherwise indicated.

MAXIMUM LOADING CAPACITY

- The weight of the cargo must not exceed the following maximum loading capacity:

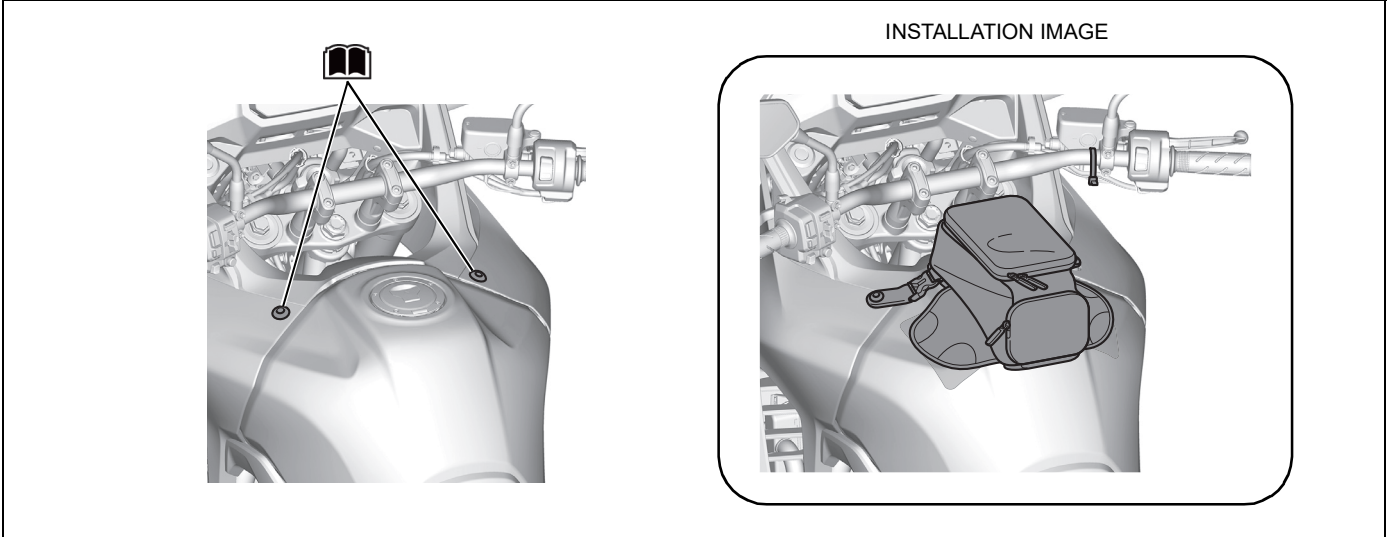

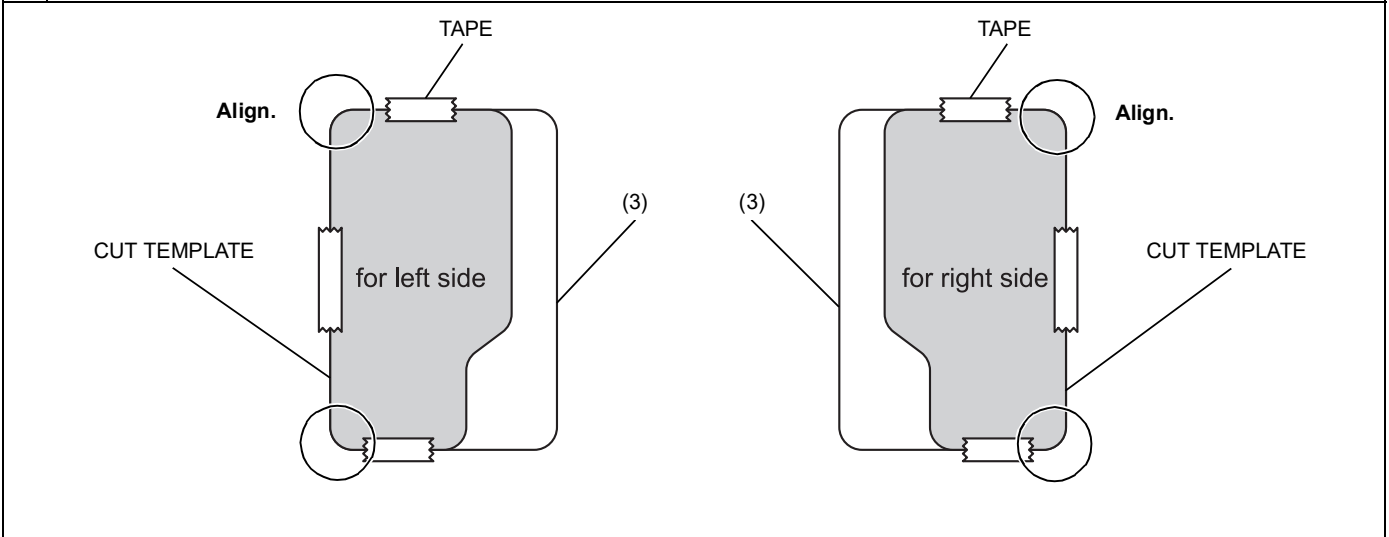

INSTALLATION

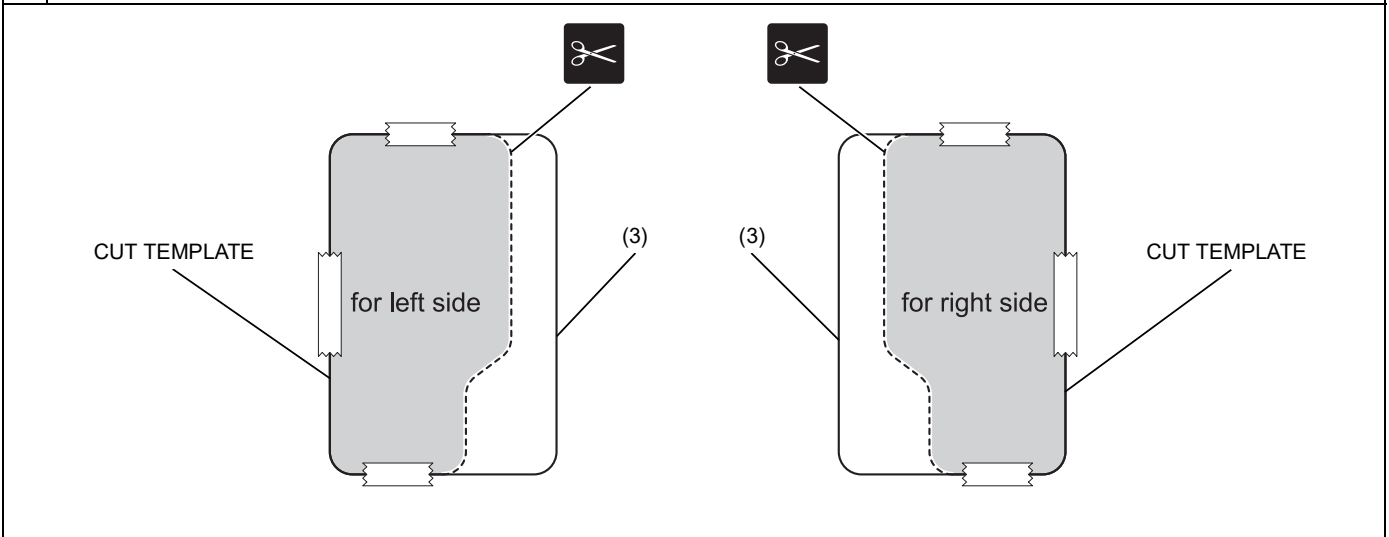
1. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the motorcycle parts as shown. (📖)



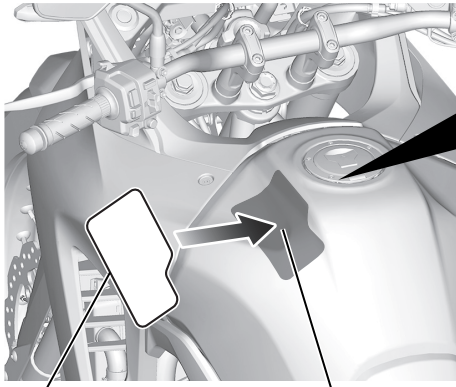
2. Cut the template along the dotted line and attach it to the protective film.



3. Cut the protective film along the template line as shown.



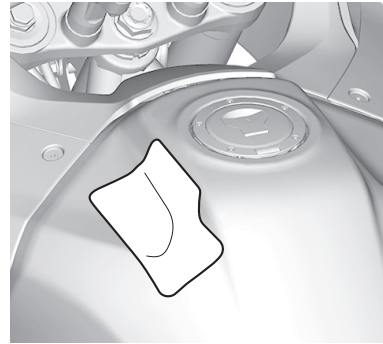
4. Install as shown.
• Repeat on the right side.



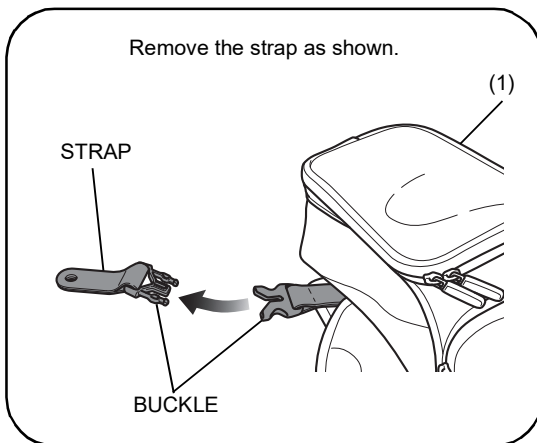

Remove the adhesive backing before attaching.



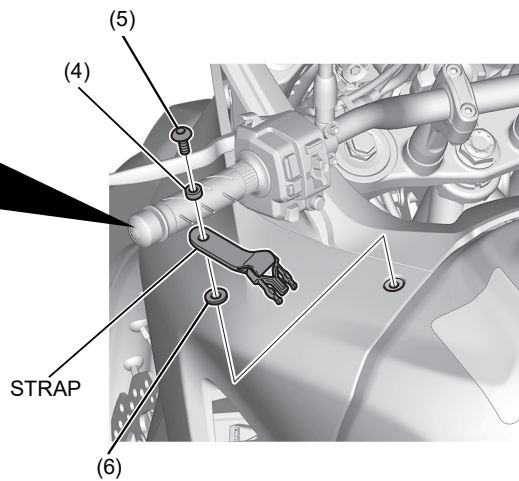
Attach the protective film as shown.



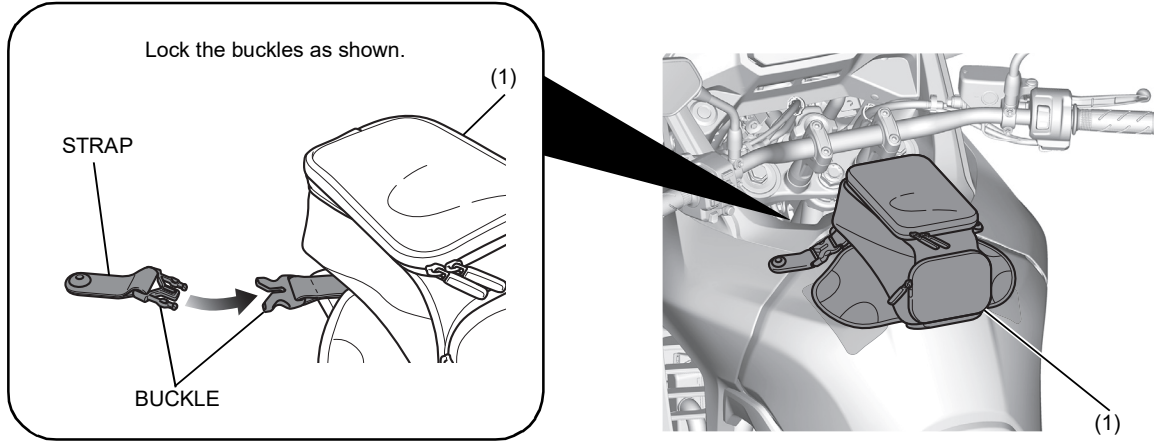
5. Install as shown.
