


### **INSTALLATION**

# **A** CAUTION


 To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc. to cool before installing the accessory.

#### NOTE:


- Heat the bonding surfaces with a hair dryer if the ambient air temperature is below 21°C (70°F).
- The adhesive reaches full strength in 72 hours. Wait at least 24 hours before riding your motorcycle.
- Take care not to damage the painted surfaces of the motorcycle.
- Illustration shows CBR1000ST type, another type is similar.
- 1. Install the rubber as shown.
  - Perform this step all frame guards.
  - Be careful not to protrude the rubber from the frame guard.




2. Refer to the Service Manual for the motorcycle, remove the motorcycle parts.




- 3. Install the right frame guard as shown.
  - For easy retainer installation, align the bolt groove with the frame guard slit firmly.

- 5. Install the left frame guard as shown.
  - For easy retainer installation, align the bolt groove with the frame guard slit firmly.
