





Tighten all screws, bolts, and nuts to their specified torque values. Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.




 To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.

NOTE:


- Take care not to damage the painted surfaces of the scooter.
- Check the accessory mounts frequently and retighten if necessary.
- When removing any other accessory that is required to install this accessory, follow these instructions only.

- 1. Refer to the *Installation Instruction* of the rear carrier. Install the rear carrier.
- 2. Drill holes at the specified positions as shown.
 - Remove any burrs from the edges of the holes.





- 3. Loosely install the rear trunk as shown.
 - First install the left and right stays, then install the basket stay.



4. Tighten all loosely installed hardware to the specified torque value.
