
- Heat the bonding surfaces with a hair dryer if the ambient air temperature is below 21°C (70°F).
- The adhesive reaches full strength in 72 hours. Wait at least 24 hours before riding your motorcycle.
- Save all removed parts unless otherwise indicated.

Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values including standard torque of the removed parts. 

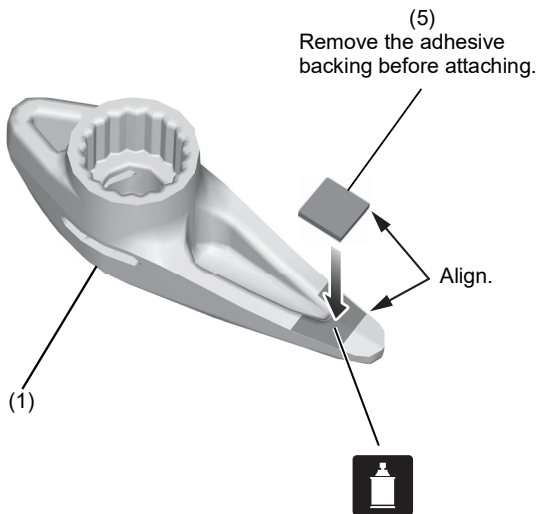

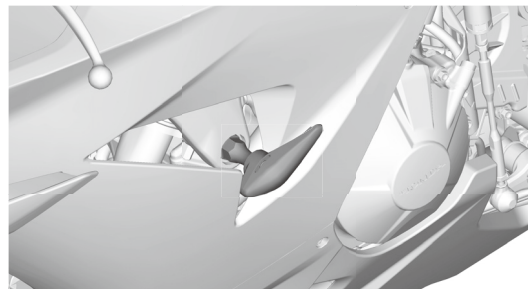
INSTALLATION

 - Be careful not to protrude the rubber from the frame guard.

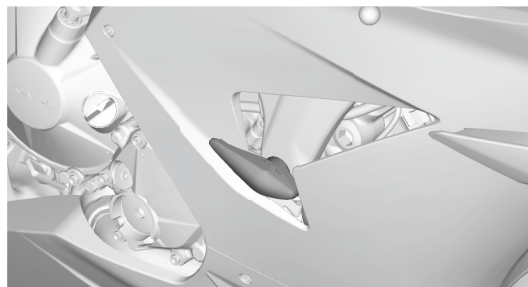


INSTALLATION IMAGE

<LEFT SIDE>

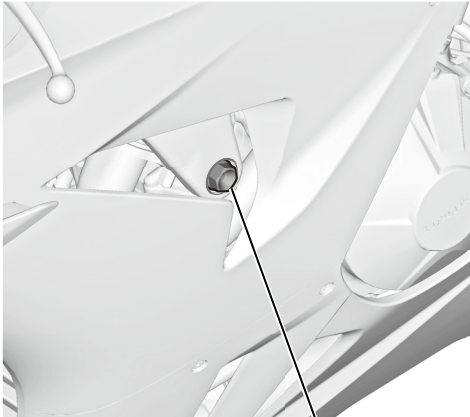


<RIGHT SIDE>

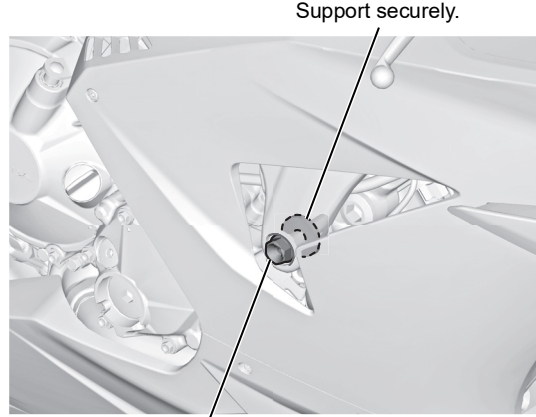


2. Refer to the Service Manual for motorcycle, remove the motorcycle parts as shown. (📖)

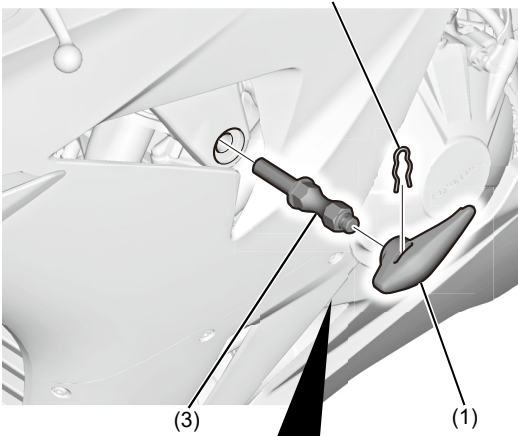

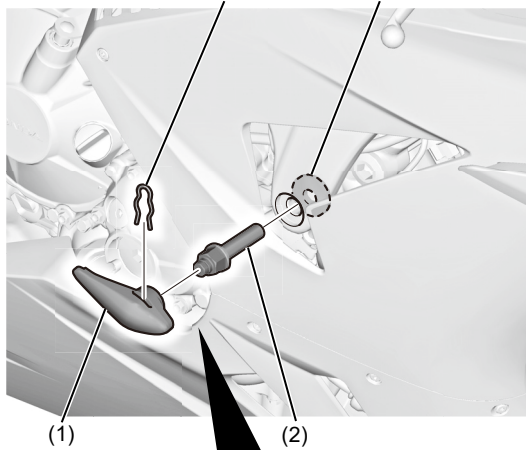


3. Install as shown.
 • For easy retainer installation, align the bolt groove with the frame guard slit firmly.

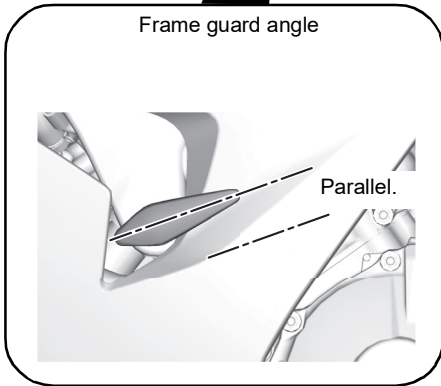
